

Concert Make-Up Assignment

Students who miss a concert because of illness, religious beliefs, or other event, are still responsible for making up the points awarded for concert attendance. If students are absent due to illness, they may make up all the credit for the concert. If students choose to attend some other function, or do not work out their schedule, only half the points will be available for make-up. Either way, students must:

- 1) Pick a classical piece of music to listen to and critique
- 2) Approve this piece with the teacher.
- 3) listen to the piece and write a 2 page review of the selection. This can include composer information, historical information, and a commentary of what was heard from the selection.
- 4) turn in the assignment, reveal what was found to the rest of the class, and bring in the selection for the class to listen to.

When this is accomplished, the student will be awarded the adequate points missed for the concert.

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
